Discussion questions from the teaching on 2/14/16:

What was the mindset of Jesus? What do you think it means to have something as a mindset?

Can you think of other places that Jesus taught us to serve others?

Jesus was willing to wash feet, can you think of any form of serving others that Jesus would not have been willing to do?

In John 13 we read about Jesus washing the disciples feet. We talked about how there would not have been a host to do this job. Why do you think that none of the disciples took on this job before Jesus?

Is there any significance to the fact that this episode occurred at the last supper after the disciples had spent nearly 3 years with Jesus?

Do you believe that each of us is gifted in some way to serve others within our ekklesia at Mosaic?

What is your giftedness, what's something you can do that would serve this body well?

Who do you think of when you hear the phrase "the least of these"?

Be honest, as you think of serving others have you thought of anything that's below your paygrade? What and why? Should it be?

Can you think of examples of people that lead a quiet life of service...and it speaks loudly for Christ?

Discussion questions from the article:

Who and/or how did you serve this week?

How did you feel while doing it (obligated, nervous, excited,...)?

How have you felt thinking back on it (regret, happy, satisfied,...)?

What would it take for us to become more conscious of the opportunities to serve that surround us each day?

How can we be more intentional about creating a lifestyle of service?
