Discussion questions from the teaching on 2/25/18:

What comes to your mind when you think of methods of evangelism?

Do you think of these things positively or negatively? Why?

Do you believe that God uses a variety of methods to reach a variety of people? What does that say about God?

What do you think it would look like to have the spiritual gift of Evangelism?

Do you believe you may have the spiritual gift of Evangelism?

Have you heard of relational evangelism before? What comes to mind when you think of it?

Would you be more likely to share the gospel with a stranger or a friend? Why?

What do you think of when you hear: We want to be good friends and neighbors having front porch discussions and backyard barbeque's?

In John 1, Matthew 9, and Luke 9 people are invited to come and meet Jesus...Is that possible today?

What would it look like today since Jesus would not be a physical person in the room?

Do you agree that genuine love always has an agenda that is ultimately the best interests of the beloved?

Do you agree we have to be intentional about evangelism? Why or why not?

Do you believe that statistics that anywhere from 1/2 to 2/3 of unchurched people would likely visit church if invited by a friend?

Do you believe that only 2% of church attenders have invited an unchurched person in the last two years? How many in our group have invited someone to church in the last 2 years or so?

What do you think Jesus meant when He said: John 6:44

"No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws them, and I will raise them up at the last day. ?

What are some things we can do to help make us more mindful to be praying?

Challenge everyone to think of and be praying for at least one person that they could share the Gospel with and/or invite to church on Easter to hear the Gospel.
